INTERNAL Memo: Coronavirus (COVID-19) and Flu Prevention

Date: March 12, 2020

To: All employees

The world health community continues to monitor closely the emergence of the SARS-CoV-2 virus and the disease it causes, named "coronavirus disease 2019" (COVID-19). At this time, no one knows how severe this outbreak will be. Given this uncertainty, and the fact that the seasonal influenza (flu) virus is also widespread, we are taking proactive steps to address a number of business concerns. First and foremost, we want to maintain a safe workplace and encourage and/or adopt practices protecting the health of employees, customers, visitors or others.

We ask all employees to cooperate in taking steps to reduce the transmission of communicable diseases in the workplace. Employees are reminded of the following:

- Wash your hands frequently with warm, soapy water for at least 20 seconds.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose or mouth with unwashed hands.
- Avoid people who are sick with respiratory symptoms.
- Coughing or sneezing into your sleeve and not your hands.
- Clean frequently touched surfaces.
- Stay home if you have symptoms of COVID-19.

Red Sun Farms will provide alcohol-based hand sanitizers throughout the workplace and in common areas. Cleaning sprays and wipes will also be provided to clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces such as telephones and keyboards.

We have suspended non-essential business travel until further notice.

Red Sun Farms will follow all official recommendations of the World Health Organizaiton (WHO), the Center for Disease Control (CDC), the Public Health Agency of Canada and the local governing health departments.
