TALKING POINTS:

When in doubt, think Connect (why is it important to YOU?), Contrast (what's missing?), Solve (how can the government/candidate help?)

- **Connect:** Regulatory reform that supports future innovations, while avoiding uniquely Canadian regulatory requirements, would contribute to the fresh produce industry's competitiveness, now and in a post-pandemic world.
- **Contrast:** While the government's move toward increased consultation with industry is welcome, work remains to ensure that these consultations provide benefit to both government and stakeholders.
- **Solve:** A comprehensive review of the regulatory modernization process would allow the government to better facilitate thorough stakeholder participation, to better understand the administrative or other costs of proposed changes, and to develop effective regulations that meet the needs of both industry and the Canadian public without stifling economic competitiveness.
